ENHANCING THE RIGHT TO

SOCIAL INCLUSION THROUGH SERVICE INTEGRATION

0 The **ERSISI** project is a social policy experiment. It is aimed at improving public service responses to unemployed people in situation or at risk of social exclusion. Integrated counselling is provided to **500 people** in two pilot areas of Navarra through a coordinated system of social services and employment services. **ALSASUA** 100 people PAMPLONA **TUDELA** 400 people **ERSISI** encompasses **DUAL RIGHT** to three main components: LOCAL **NETWORKS** INTEGRATED **DELIVERY** of applying a personcentred approach.

DUAL RIGHT

Social Inclusion + Guaranteed Income

At the outset of the project, a regional law governing **the rights to a guaranteed income** and **to social inclusion** was adopted in November 2016.

The integrated delivery of social services and employment services is carried out by case-handlers who work in pairs on every single case.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Each pair combines a social work specialist with another advisor who is expert in employment.

The whole process is supported by **local networks.** These are permanent **working groups made up of public as well as private actors** that have fostered the generation of opportunities for activating the unemployed.



This law widens the social protection coverage of low income households, while at the same time guarantees social inclusion services. It establishes the right to receive support from public services for all citizens at risk of social exclusion.

The project shows that is possible to merge the perspectives of different public services. In that way, together they can achieve greater quality and effectiveness when supporting the process of social inclusion.
